
This diversity fosters innovative ideas, sometimes unconventional, yet always rooted in our core values, as reflected in this press kit.




VIP PASS

For every night spent in Verbier, Val de Bagnes - La Tzoumaz, visitors will receive a free VIP Pass. The Verbier Infinite Playground Pass (VIP Pass) offers discounts and privileged access to the entire area throughout the summer season. It is provided free of charge to all guests staying a minimum of one night in the region and paying the tourist tax. Whether among friends or family, if you're a nature lover or a thrill seeker, everyone will find something to

enjoy in the region! Benefits offered by the VIP Pass include free ski lift access for pedestrians and 50% reduction for cyclists, unlimited access to postbuses in the municipality of Val de Bagnes, preferential rates on a number of activities offered by destination partners, and 50% discount on entertainment provided by Verbier, Le Châble and La Tzoumaz tourist offices.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

By gondola → Considered a form of public transport, the Le Châble - Verbier lifts operate from 5.15 am to 11.50 pm every day.

By bus → In Verbier, shuttle buses run free of charge from July to early September. Various buses make it easier to reach the most unspoilt places in our destination: Lourtier - Barrage de Mauvoisin, Sarreyer, Le Levron, Cabane Brunet. This bus service is free for all VIP PASS holders.


By train → From Martigny station, the regional train to Le Châble takes 25 minutes and drops passengers at the base of the gondola station to Verbier.

VERBIER BIKEPARK

Thanks to its renowned bike park and more than 800 km of trails and mountain roads, Verbier is regarded as one of the mountain bike capitals of Switzerland - and one of the best in Europe. The Verbier Bikepark now offers nine different trails with unique landscapes, catering to various skill levels, from beginner to competition. These trails span between Les Fontanets (2,475 m), Verbier (1,535 m), and the side of La Tzoumaz, providing 19 km of pure adrenaline!

2025 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Next year, the Valais will host the 2025 Mountain Bike World Championships. For the first time ever, the World Championships will bring together all seven mountain bike disciplines on the same dates and in the same region: Cross-Country (Crans-Montana), Downhill (Région Dents du Midi), E-Bike (Loèche-les-Bains), Enduro (Aletsch Arena), Marathon (Verbier et le Val d'Anniviers), Pumptrack (Monthey), Short Track (Zermatt) and the opening ceremony and events (Sion).

CORBASSIÈRE FOOTBRIDGE

High above Fionnay, in the deepest part of the Val de Bagnes, you'll find the Corbassière glacier. Besides being a route on various walking trails such as the Tour des Combins or the Val de Bagnes, it's also a popular destination for hikers. At this altitude of 2,365 metres, the desert terrain is made up of ice, rock and moraine. The path, which until recently crossed the glacier tongue, became dangerous when the permafrost melted. It was replaced in 2014 by one of the highest galvanised steel structures in Europe: the Corbassière footbridge. Its cables stretch almost 70 metres above ground with a span of 190 metres, offering walkers a memorable experience and a magnificent view of the surrounding area. Crossing the void is impressive and 100% safe.

TOUR DES STATIONS: 31 AUGUST — 1ST SEPTEMBER

For its 7th edition, the Tour des Stations now encompasses 30 tourist destinations, representing 50 nationalities and is expected to attract over 3,500 participants. For the latter, regardless of the chosen route's length, the promise of reaching exceptional resorts in a magnificent environment serves as the primary motivator. One distinguishing feature of this bike race is its unique challenge: to conquer the elevation gain equivalent to Mount Everest in a single day! However, participants have the option to conquer 'their own summit' among the six routes available, starting in Le Châble and finishing in Verbier.



This five-day itinerary immerses hikers in an alpine setting with a backdrop of the Combins, Vélan and Mont-Blanc massifs. The 90-km journey is suitable for both trail runners and hikers, and crosses mountain passes, including the Col des Otanes, the highest point of the tour at 2,846 m, spends restful nights in the renowned huts of the valley (Chanrion, Brunet, Mont-Fort and FXB Panossière), and passes by impressive sites such as the Corbassière glacier, the Mauvoisin dam, the Louvie lake, the Col des Mines. All these ingredients are sure to make this trek a highlight in every hiker's calendar.


CAMPING BONATCHIESSE

For this reason, it is listed in the IFP (Federal Inventory of Landscapes, Sites and Monuments of National Importance) to protect its natural and unspoilt character. The region is also a federal free zone where the fauna is protected to allow the wildlife to regenerate and preserve a healthy population.



The Verbier-Val de Bagnes and St-Bernard region is renowned as a haven for trail running enthusiasts. It has hosted prestigious races like the Ultra Trail du Mont-Blanc (UTMB) and the Trail Verbier-St-Bernard (Trail VSB), attracting some of the sport's most illustrious names. With 21 marked routes, the region caters to both seasoned athletes and novice runners, offering a diverse range of trails. From the grandeur of majestic glaciers to serene green pastures where Hérens cows graze, and from meandering rivers to impressive dams, runners can explore the region's multifaceted landscapes. Local trail experts like Jules-Henri Gabioud, winner of the Tor des Géants in 2011 and second in the PTL in 2019, along with Emily Vaudan, who secured third place in the X-Alpine du Trail VSB, have meticulously crafted an exceptional network of 415 km of routes, featuring 33,000 m of vertical gain. These trails not only offer exhilarating running experiences but also showcase the rich cultural and natural heritage of the region.

BLUEARK — INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS FOR WATER SAVING

BlueArk is a technology innovation hub and laboratory based in Le Châble. Founded in 2018, it specialises in the management of natural resources, with a particular focus on the smart management and digitalisation of water. Its goal is to encourage and develop practical and innovative solutions to the challenges of climate change, particularly in the field of water. The ODILE project is a specific example of this. To help mountain farmers, a network of sensors has been installed to determine if and when to water the alpine meadows. If necessary, automatic valves are opened. As well as saving farmers extra work and unnecessary travel, this system also saves water and provides more fodder for the livestock.

SARREYER & ITS SLOW FOOD COMMUNITY

Head for Sarreyer and discover the work of the members of the first Slow Food Community in Switzerland. At a bend in a steep alleyway, meet the village's chocolate maker, known for flavouring their creations with unusual local delicacies. A little further on, walk through a garden with the plant grower who cultivates aromatic and medicinal herbs. Continue to the mill, still in operation, and you will see the

artisanal distillery where massage oils and liqueurs are produced. Below, you can watch the cows and sheep of the Glariers farm wander around. While meeting, discussing and tasting, you will uncover the subtle link between man and nature in Sarreyer.

Since ancient Neolithic times. the Val de Bagnes region has been deeply rooted in agriculture. Today, this tradition continues with local farmers driving the region's dynamism. With a strong connection to nature, the area prides itself on authenticity and human warmth, values cherished by its residents throughout history.

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ALPAGE DE LA CHAUX

Alpine pastures are an essential part of the Alpine landscape. Not only do they maintain the landscape and biodiversity of alpine meadows, which would be overgrown by forest if the animals didn't graze there, but they also contribute to the production of the renowned Raclette d'alpage cheese. In La Chaux, the Luisier family, who own a farm in the village of Sarreyer further down the valley, look after the alpine pastures and their cows, producing their cheese on site at an altitude of 2,200 m. Their dedication to excellence has been recognised by prestigious entities like the Raclette du Valais AOP interprofession and the Swiss Cheese Awards, which have bestowed numerous medals and prizes upon the La Chaux alpage for their exceptional cheese production.

BEEKEEPING COMPETENCE CENTRE

Bees play a crucial role in our ecosystems and agriculture, serving as vital indicators of environmental health. However, their alarming mortality rates raise concerns. In response, the Société apicole d'Entremont has initiated a pioneering project in Switzerland: the Beekeeping Competence Centre. Opening this summer along the banks of the Dranse river near Sembrancher, the centre will serve as a hub for research, beekeeper education, apitherapy, and the sale of honey and hive products. Over time, the centre and its surrounding outdoor spaces will evolve into a year-round visitor destination, fostering awareness and knowledge about beekeeping.

This event celebrates the gastronomic heritage of these regions and raises awareness about mountain agriculture. The Grand Market of Alpine Terroirs is a must-visit for stocking up on local mountain delicacies, discovering new recipes from renowned chefs, and indulging in wines and cheeses from various Alpine regions. The event will feature workshops, roundtable discussions and entertainment, all set in the festive and welcoming atmosphere of PALP. Expect music, dance and cultural delights while engaging in debates about the Alps' significance as a unified region.




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BAGNES CAPITALE DE LA RACLETTE: 21 — 22 SEPTEMBER

This is one of the largest events celebrating local products and, of course, cheese, and it all happens in Le Châble! More than 15,000 foodies from all walks of life gather for a weekend to indulge in cheeses and raclettes that come from local producers in the Bagnes valley and Entremont district. On Sunday, the original producers of these cheeses are in the spotlight - the "queens" (both horned and dairy cattle) from various mountain pastures parade the streets accompanied by their own folk dance and music troupe.

SHEPHERDS' HUTS & VAULTED STABLES

Shepherds' huts (îtres) and vaulted stables (écuries) dot the landscape on the pastures of the Val de Bagnes at an altitude of between 1,800 and 2,500 m. More than 600 buildings have been recorded and the presence of humans on these sites has been documented back to the Mesolithic period. About 30 of these buildings have been restored using the original dry stone technique. The Association ArcAre has also been working since 2013 to protect and revive this mountain heritage. Find out more on walking tours such as the Tour des Ecuries du Crêt and Vasevay or the Tour du Lac de Mauvoisin via the Giétro and Lia stables.

THE GUARDIAN ANGELS OF VAL DE BAGNES

Understanding and respecting nature isn't something that's simply taught; it's gained through firsthand experience. Interacting with protected areas and their quardians allows us to develop a profound appreciation for living in harmony with the natural world. In the Val de Bagnes, extensive natural landscapes, particularly in the Upper Val de Bagnes, require preservation. This summer, a dedicated team of rangers will patrol the Upper Val de Bagnes to help people understand how to live in harmony with nature. They'll provide information, answer questions and assist visitors, aiming to promote a healthy balance between recreational activities, agriculture, tourism and the pres-



ervation of protected areas.

At the entrance to the Espace Nature, in the Forest House (Maison de la Forêt), two exhibitions await families this summer. One, the Animals of the Forest, allows you to discover, touch and listen to the calls of several local species of birds and mammals that inhabit the woods. The other offers a deep dive into the forest ecosystem from original perspectives (through the eyes of animals, plants and even tiny mushrooms).

HÔTEL DE MAUVOISIN

The Hôtel de Mauvoisin, built in 1863, holds a significant place in the history of Val de Bagnes. Perched atop a rocky peak with sweeping views of rugged gorges, it has witnessed the pinnacle of mountaineering, the conquest of peaks, the growth of summer tourism, and the construction of hydroelectric dams, notably the nearby dam completed in 1957. Today, the original structure remains remarkably intact, offering various accommodations including a dormitory, as well as single, double, and triple rooms. Within these historic walls, the hotel provides a culinary experience characterised by quality, simplicity, and authenticity, catering to hikers and mountaineers setting out from this renowned establishment on their adventures.

MAUVOISIN DAM

At Mauvoisin, art and history come together in a breathtaking setting. Located in the Upper Val de Bagnes nature reserve and built between 1951 and 1958, the Mauvoisin dam stands tall as a remarkable 250-m-high concrete structure, earning its distinction as the tallest arch dam in Europe. To explore the captivating history of its construction, visitors can follow a dedicated trail along the dam's crest, which includes passage through a historic 392-m-long gallery.

Artistry also graces the foot of the dam, where Michael Heizer, a renowned Land Art artist born in California in 1944, presents his masterpiece «Tangential Circular Negative Line Sculpture.» This artwork is inspired by a sign Heizer drew four decades earlier in the Nevada desert sands using his motorcycle. Once ephemeral, this sign now finds a permanent home, perpetuated by its striking setting at the base of the Mauvoisin dam.

Inside the Musée de Bagnes, the «Faire (avec)» exhibition challenges us to confront the future. Operating entirely without electricity, the museum transforms into a space of creative exploration. Dusty tools, spare parts, forgotten doc-

uments and faded images are displayed alongside regional heritage, inviting visitors to decipher, reimagine and reinvent. The message is clear: the solutions for tomorrow lie in harnessing the ingenuity of the past.

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Sitting at a crossroads, Le Châble is a peaceful haven where you can enjoy life at a traditional pace.

The capital of the Bagnes commune, Le Châble is linked to Verbier and Bruson by gondolas, which depart from next to the train station. Traditional customs play an important part in the hearts of locals, who keep them alive through a number of popular festivals, including 'Bagnes, capital of raclette', the flagship event for the region. It's held every year at the contemporary Espace Saint-Marc event centre, which also has an outdoor playground and an urban sports area with a skate park and pump track.

The picturesque villages of the Upper Val de Bagnes are a favourite destination for nature lovers and travellers looking for authenticity. Follow the Dranse de Bagnes river, and you'll come across villages with lilting names: Lourtier, Fionnay, Sarreyer and Bonatchiesse - all little corners of paradise where you can forget time and indulge in slow food. A hidden treasure, the preserved natural area of the Upper Val de Bagnes is protected in the Federal Inventory of Landscapes. The exceptionally rich landscape demands respect and a certain humility from hikers. Ibex, chamois, bearded vultures as well as red frogs and butterflies all call this remote, wild place home. And at the end of the valley, where the road ends, is the majestic Mauvoisin dam, the last trace of civilisation before you get to Italy.

On the hills high above the Val de Bagnes, Bruson is a charming mountain village with stone and wood chalets, and 400 or so permanent residents. It provides visitors with a calm, authentic Alpine setting. Here, life is closely linked to agriculture, and a new local, community-based economy has been developed. The annual Palp Festival - which brings together contemporary music, art and traditions - takes place in Bruson and runs a grocery shop called La Brusonette. Near the beginning of the Bisse des Ravines trail, Eddy Baillifard, the Swiss ambassador for Raclette - or 'Mr Raclette' himself - serves his famous cheese dishes year-round. And to top it all off, marked paths and enduro trails criss-cross the surrounding area much to the delight of walkers and mountain bikers.


On the northern slopes of Verbier, overlooking the Rhône valley, the village of La Tzoumaz, formerly known as 'Mayens-de-Riddes' comes from the word 'tzoumer' in Valaisan dialect, meaning the place where you rest. 

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


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
