



The combined destination of Verbier - Val de Bagnes -La Tzoumaz offers visitors over 300 km² of fun and adventure. Six gems with a wide range of charms - cosmopolitan Verbier, accessible Le Châble, wild Upper Val de Bagnes, authentic Bruson, discreet Vollèges and family-friendly La Tzoumaz - each with its own distinct character, serve as ideal base camps for exploring the Bagnes region.

The 4 Vallées, Switzerland's largest ski area, caters for all winter enthusiasts, offering alpine skiing, freeriding, cross-country skiing, ski touring and snowshoeing. Legendary slopes and peaks create a paradise for either climbing up or sliding down. Multiple top-quality venues, be they traditional or trendy, have gained renown for an excellent art of living (art de vivre).

This lively, dynamic destination's heart beats to the rhythm of an action-packed winter events calendar: the Polaris Festival, the Verbier Art Summit and, of course, the Xtreme Verbier. Excitement and strong emotions all concentrated in this one spot, in the heart of Valais.

And the sheer size and variety of the area to be discovered is reflected in the diversity of its visitors. From sporty early risers to late-night revellers, extreme thrill-seekers or those seeking simple pleasures, trendsetters or regional enthusiasts, extroverts and introverts, in Verbier all these contrasting characters come together to create a unique mix.







The 4 Vallées, the largest ski area in Switzerland, unites six resorts: Verbier. La Tzoumaz, Bruson, Nendaz, Veysonnaz and Thyon, creating a playground of 410km of runs (24 blue, 39 red and 10 black), connected by 80 ski lifts.



SNOW IN ABUNDANCE

With an altitude range of 1,500 to 3,330 m, but the majority of its slopes above 2,000 m, Verbier 4 Vallées is one of the highest ski areas in Europe. In addition to that, 63% of the area is covered by artificial snowmaking capacity, ensuring good snow depth over a long period.

THE 'NOT-TO-BE-MISSED' MONT-FORT EXPERIENCE

The viewing platform at the top of Mont-Fort, at an altitude of just over 3,300 m, offers visitors an exceptional 360-degree panorama of the entire Alpine mountain range, from Mont Blanc to the Matterhorn. The more adventurous, who want to extend the experience and continue to take in the view (providing they keep their eyes open), can soar over the Tortin glacier at speeds of up to 130 km/h on the Mont 4 Zipline, over a distance of 1.4 km and a vertical drop of 383 m.

OUTDOOR ART WALK

In winter, nature and culture live side by side on the heights above Verbier. At an altitude of 2,300 m, between Les Ruinettes and La Chaux, works of art created and exhibited by international artists are dotted throughout the snowy landscape. Accessible all year round, the 3-D Sculpture Park can be visited in winter on foot, with snowshoes or on a dog sled ride, so everyone can enjoy and experience this exhibition without walls in their own way.

A SKI TOURING WEEKEND GETAWAY

A weekend plan that associates sport with contemplation. Starting at the La Barmasse car park, the trail begins with a climb up a forest path. Halfway up is a small clearing, ideal for taking a break and admiring the views of the surrounding mountains, including the imposing "le Pleureur" which crowns the far end of the Bagnes valley. With the scenery absorbed and energy restored, the route continues through the forest until it reaches a snow-covered road with a gentler incline which leads to a mountain hut at an altitude of 2,100 m. At the Cabane Brunet, the Corthay family welcomes hikers and provides a generous selection of traditional dishes, not forgetting Grandma's famous apple pie! Then it is time to get some sleep in one of the refuge's recently updated **six** bedrooms. Following a good breakfast the next morning, the climb goes higher still, to the Col du Rogneux. Those feeling up to it can continue along the ridge to the summit of Mont Rogneux. Hiring a guide is strongly recommended.

Food-lovers should not miss out on the joy of a picnic at the foot of the Grand Combin massif, before launching down the off-piste descent back to the la Barmasse car park.

Day 1: Barmasse – Cabane Brunet : 2-hr climb 7 km / 750 m D+

Day 2: Cabane Brunet – Col du Rogneux : 2-hr climb 5km / 750 m D+ (allow 45 additional minutes' climb / 600 m and 200 m D+ to reach the summit)

FUN SKI ZONES

Carving, freeride, slalom, freestyle? They're all available in the Verbier 4Vallées area! **Various fun zones** allow skiers to try out and improve different forms of skiing in a playful and exciting way. For all ages, the place to go is La Chaux to try out the Verbier Snowpark, the **Copperfield School Skicross or the mini KL** (mini speed track), or to Savoleyres to whizz down the Copperfield School **Funslope** or test proficiency on the two **slalom** courses (Sud and Casino).

BACK TO CHILDHOOD WITH THE JOYS OF SLEDGING

No need to be a winter sports professional to zoom down the La Tzoumaz toboggan run, all that's required are strong nerves. From either Verbier or La Tzoumaz, sledgers start from the summit of the Savoleyres cable car (2,354 m), where jaw-dropping vistas of the Grand Combin and the Rhône Valley await. From there, it's a 7kmlong, 711 m-drop, adrenaline rush, with laughter from start to finish. Open to all. Wearing a helmet is strongly advised. Hire toboggans in resort or at the top of the run in Savoleyres.

INTÉGRALE DU ROGNEUX: OPEN-TO-ALL SKI-MOUNTAINEERING RACE 8 FEBRUARY 2025

The Intégrale du Rogneux is an open-to-all ski-mountaineering race which takes place every two years and starts from the village of Lourtier. Organised by the Grand-Combin Ski Club, this competition, for teams of two, attracts both amateur and elite athletes of all ages and all levels. The main race goes from Lourtier to the summit of Mont Rogneux in one long climb and then descends back to Lourtier after 18 km of physical exertion and nearly 2,000 m of altitude difference. Alternative races, one with 1,000 m of altitude

difference and one for kids, are also available to make sure everyone can join in the fun. Entertainment and food and drink stalls throughout the day create a festive atmosphere for spectators in Lourtier. The Intégrale du Rogneux has become an essential date in the ski-mountaineering calendar. Over 600 racers, local and international, are expected to take part in this eighth edition.

The Xtreme Verbier is THE iconic freeride competition that, since 1996, takes place every year on the north face of the Bec des Rosses, in Verbier. This contest, which marks the final of the Freeride World Tour, sees the crowning of the world champions in the discipline. The Bec des Rosses, at 3,222m high with an average gradient of 50 degrees, is an extreme and technical playground on which only a handful of the world's top riders get to compete. The Xtreme Verbier is not just a competition, it is also a celebration of freeride culture, showcasing the technical and mental demands of the discipline, the importance of safety and preparation in the mountains, the virtuosity of the athletes and the incredible excitement of this sport.

SLEDGING FESTIVAL: FOR KIDS AND ADULTS 8 FEBRUARY 2025

The Sledging Festival at La Tzoumaz is an unmissable event for anyone who loves winter sports and socialising. Each year, a large number of participants get together to hurtle down one of the longest toboggan runs in the Frenchspeaking part of Switzerland, from the top lift station at Savoleyres down to the lift station at La Tzoumaz. The mood is friendly and laidback, with musical entertainment and surprises for kids and adults. Some participants turn up in costume and use old fashioned wooden sledges, adding a touch of nostalgia and pageantry to the day. To make the event accessible to as wide a public as possible, there is a special CHF 30.- package including sledge or plastic toboggan rental, lift pass and drinks at Savoleyres and Etablons.




LA TZOUMAZ

- 1. Bar des Etablons: the 'must' for après-ski before the final run of the day.
- 2. T-Bar: great choice of beers and authentic setting.
- 3. Le Central: reopening this winter for après-ski and a bit later.

- W Off Piste: chic terrace vibe at the bot-4. tom of the slopes in the Place Blanche.
- 5. Médran Café: a central hub to kick off après-ski before heading down the main street from Médran.
- 6. Lumi: ideally placed spot with live music, the full package with a big welcome.
- 7. Pub Mont Fort: legendary venue with large terrace and great atmosphere every night.
- 8. Fer à Cheval: one of the best-placed terraces in Verbier, in the middle of the most busy thoroughfare.
- Farinet: another iconic venue with 9 a wide and cosmopolitan following, its large terrace commands the view over the Place Centrale.
- 10. South Club: nightclub directly under the Farinet, handy for transitioning from après-ski to all-night dancing.
- 11. No 8: situated on the Place Centrale, drinks-tapas bar, great sounds, party vibe and karaoke on Sundays.
- 12. Alp & Horn: contemporary alpine pub with a large range of draft beers, plus a pub bites menu with house speciality tartes flambées.

- 13. Rabbit Hutch: speakeasy-style bar with extraordinary cocktails, cosy vibe and sunny terrace.
- 14. Experimental Chalet: craft cocktails and a refined selection of wines and spirits, the perfect après-ski and pre-party hideout.
- 15. Farm Club: legendary nightclub, it has been the place to see and be seen for over 50 years.
- 16. Crock No Name: a night-time institution in Verbier, reinvented tapas menu, diverse cocktails including the mandatory Expresso Martini.
- 17. Le Rouge: friendly atmosphere with panoramic terrace at the foot of the slopes



TRADITIONAL DINING

Raclette, potence, croûte: if these intriguing names don't instantly stimulate the taste buds, sampling them will! In Val de Bagnes, homeland and Capital of Raclette, raclette is much more than a tradition - it is an art, a way of life. For an authentic taste of raclette, crafted with the finest Bagnes PDO cheese, of course, head to Eddy's Raclett'House in Bruson or Le Caveau in Verbier. Another outstanding Bagnes speciality is the potence (gallows) - succulent meat flambéed on a spiked metal apparatus which can be enjoyed at the Hôtel La Vallée in Lourtier or the au Vieux Verbier restaurant. As for croûtes. grilled cheese dishes, whether plain or topped with mushrooms, la Marmotte restaurant is the place!

Venturing into the Verbier sector, head for Le Dahu or Le Bistrot. The first, a popular restaurant of exceptional quality, has a large terrace with a view of the Grand Combin massif. Le Bistrot, perched on the summit of Les Attelas, in a cosy setting, offers a bistronomic menu using local produce.

And last but not least, for those heading to Bruson, the little restaurant La Grange à Tienne Oeudan, surprises with its stunning terrace, friendly vibe and specialities from Valais.

For those who appreciate fine dining, Verbier is home to a diverse range of restaurants guaranteed to delight connoisseurs and food lovers. Under the direction of Sebastiano Lombardi, La Table d'Adrien (16 points in the Gault&Millau Guide, 1 Michelin star) offers Italian-inspired gourmet cuisine.

Mediterranean flavours also characterise the cuisine at La Channe (12 points in the Gault&Millau Guide), an establishment directed by Marco Bassi.

At W Verbier's restaurant **Bô!** (14 points in the Gault&Millau Guide) chef Emiliano Vignoni proposes an extraordinary and refined culinary journey.

At La Grange (13 points in the Gault&Millau Guide), local Thierry Corthay prepares exceptional regional produce in a welcoming setting.

Meanwhile, in the elegant surroundings of La Cordée des Alpes (14 points in the Gault&Millau Guide) Romain Maillot gives free rein to his imagination and his cosmopolitan and Réunion influences.

Another noteworthy restaurant, speakeasy in style, is **Le Vingt Deux** (a selected restaurant in the Michelin Guide 2023), an ultra-discreet table d'hôte, directed by chef Maxime Gombaud.

Taratata (a new entry in the Gault&Millau Guide 2024 with 13 points), housed in a former night club, with its laid-back atmosphere and its butcher's counter, is ideal for a relaxed evening.

Beyond Verbier, in a converted former sheep stable in the village of Etiez, young chef Jérémie Voutaz (21 years old) works solo in his table d'hôte À Table.

ACCESSIBLE VERBIER

Verbier may be perched 1,500 m up in the Alps, but it has transport links that make it easy to get to from anywhere. With a train station at the heart of the destination, its proximity to Geneva Airport and the crossroads of Switzerland with France and Italy, Verbier is infinitely reachable by train, car or plane: or any combination thereof.



EASY TO REACH BY TRAIN


Having reached Geneva by train or plane, travelling the final kilometres to Verbier is as easy as it is beautiful. From the train station housed in same building as the airport, the train route skirts Lake Geneva with unbeatable scenic views. Then, with just one change, a smaller train chugs up the mountain to Le Châble where it unloads its passengers at the foot of the gondolas that lead to Verbier and onto the slopes.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

The Châble-Verbier gondola is part of the public transport network and so has an extended timetable and **operating hours from 5:15am to 22:50pm daily.** This makes it possible to get from the Le Châble train station directly onto the slopes with an intermediate stop at Verbier. In resort, there is a free **bus service which circulates from 8am to 8pm** throughout the winter season. A night bus operates during some peak periods in the season, from 8pm onwards.


VERBIER EXPRESS ET VOS ALPES

The Verbier Express train offers direct routes from Geneva to Le Châble, avoiding the need to switch trains in Martigny, and runs from mid-December to mid-April on weekends and some public holidays. Similarly, the Vos Alpes Express line connects Fribourg (CH) to Le Châble. 
